For us to run smoothly, we have had to implement rules for 2021.

- 1 Ensure your child has their own equipment if possible.
- 2 Ensure your child brings a drink and hand sanitiser to every session and match if applicable.
- 3 Please observe the one-way route round the club house.
- 4 Please always maintain 1m+ social distancing.
- 5 Breaks for hand sanitising and toilets will be every 20 minutes to comply with government and ECB guidelines.
- 6 Ensure you always stay on the ground, where you can see your child.
- 7 At least one parent per family must accompany their child to training sessions and matches if applicable.
- 8 If your child needs first aid, then we ask that a parent attend to them unless it is a major incident when a first aider will be present. We ask that you do not approach the children unless asked, due to COVID restrictions.
- 9 At the end of the session, it is parents' responsibility to ensure that your child leaves with their own equipment.
